SUBJECT: Program Applications/Program Rules for 2022 AgFest Replacement Heifer

Please note the following rule changes that have been approved by the Replacement Heifer Committee for the 2022 program. It is important that you complete ALL of the information on your application and get it into Agfest Replacement Heifer Committee on time.

One year projects: Heifers need to have been born in the months of June, July or August 2020 to qualify.

Two year projects: to be sold in 2023 must be born in the month of June, July or August of 2021 to qualify, and may not be older than 26 months as of June 30 2023.

All Sires must be of same breed and registered including home bred bulls. List the registered full name of sire with registration number this applies to BOTH sire AND the service sire.

Note: The 2022 Fairs and Exposition Guidelines have included the following: All dairy replacement heifers MUST have one of the following: **a readable tattoo; ear tag; OR a confirmation of vaccine from a veterinarian.**

Dates to Remember:

- **October 7th 2021** - Breeding date(s) may **NOT** be prior to **October 7th**.
- Should heifer calve at Agfest the calving must occur following the Replacement Show in order to sell and the calf will sell alongside the cow.
- **February 1st 2022** - Heifers must be owned by exhibitor not later than **Feb 1st**.
- **March 15th 2022** – Program Application with **CLEAR** photos with ear tag included in the photo (both sides), **dam test sheet, veterinarians verification of pregnancy, Bill of Sale**, and the completed **SIGNED Inspection Questionnaire** are due by **mail by March 15th**.
- **May ? 2022** – Online Entry/Fees to Agfest must be completed – see www.sanjoaquinaqfest.org for Entry dates.
- Applications submitted without all the required information are subject to a \$50.00 processing fee before we allow you to show.
- Postmarks on March 15th will be accepted.
- **FAXED COPIES OR EMAILED COPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

PHOTOS:

If you submitted a photo the first year of your two year project, you are not required to send in another photo the final year. All photos must show clear and distinguishable color markings. Any fuzzy, dark or **dirty** animal photos will not be accepted and could result in a \$50.00 late processing fee.
