4 IN DAIRY; 41 IN SWINE; 91 LIVESTOCK.** Scholarships discussed.

Important to make sure that the Exhibitor may only enter and exhibit 2 market animals is in the Guide Book. Discussed **Ag Mechanics** in the sale. Other options. Sale went too long in Muller Auction Ring.

Required that all Exhibitors, Leaders and Parents have a different color wrist band. This would eliminate a lot of the fitting problems by adults and out of County individuals. If in violation of this, the exhibitor's animal will be pulled from the sale.

Fee for animals pulled from the sale: Fee to be raised to \$250 on large animals and \$100 for small animals. **Must be strict on 1 hour after their specie show for withdrawal.**

CODE OF CONDUCT: Exhibitors not following the rules and parents not controlling their kids. A concern that some kids are just being dropped off with no supervision. Must be consequences.

Need more panels for movement of FFA hogs to the 4-H Barn. **Tractor Pulls:** Different options discussed
