Operations: Kari reported that the Breeding Show for Beef, Sheep, Goats and Swine will be held at the San Joaquin County Fair the week-end prior to AgFest. Dairy and small animals are not included.

SALE OF CHAMPIONS: New this year will be the Sale of Champions in the middle of the Sale in the Muller Ring approximately at noon. **Rabbits will sell in the swine ring after the pigs sell.**

Barn Chairs: We are still in need of Barn Chairs for small animals.

Breeding Showmanship: Winners of each breeding specie showmanship will be eligible to compete in Master Showmanship.

Boer Goats: Classes 1 & 2 AND 3 & 4 WILL BE COMBINED IF NOT MORE THAN 10 ENTERED.

Beef: Breeding beef will be combined is not more than 10 animals in the Division.

Rate of Gain Contest for the Beef: It is not officially part of AgFest and be completely put on by volunteers.

Breeding Show: Josh reported that it is officially going to held at the San Joaquin Co. Fair the week prior to our show. It is a Saturday and Sunday show. Possibly can be released after each show is done. He said it is a win win trade off with the Fair.

Dairy: Dairy will be coming into AgFest on Sunday due to the congestion last year.

Operations: There will be a meeting in January to start assigning jobs to people.

Exhibitors from contiguous counties in the Breeding Show: A lengthy discussion was held regarding letting out of county kids compete in our breeding show. Following the debating, Sherry moved to allow Exhibitors from contiguous counties to compete in our breeding show. It was seconded by Jed Carpenter. Vote taken: 20 in favor and 11 opposed. Motion passes.

Auction: Brian had nothing at that time.

Governance: Budget discussed.

Jr. AgFest Board: No report as the first meeting will not be held until January.
