

## **CHECK LIST FOR REPLACEMENT HEIFERS**

This is meant to be a supplement to help you navigate AgFest. Please be sure to read through all materials as listed herein for the rules and guidelines as those will supersede these.

NEW THIS YEAR: WRISTBANDS. ALL EXHIBITORS, PARENTS AND SIBLINGS WILL RECEIVE WRISTBANDS.

EXHIBITORS - YOU NEED TO HAVE YOUR WRISTBAND ON DURING THE ENTIRE AGFEST WEEK. YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE IT ON TO SHOW AND SELL YOUR ANIMAL. PLEASE HELP US MONITOR WHO IS ON THE GROUNDS DURING AGFEST AND EXHIBITING AND CARING FOR ANIMALS.

- o <u>If you need to remove your wristband for Work/Sports reasons, please cut it off and bring it to the</u> livestock office for a new one.
- o Lost wristbands you will get the 2<sup>nd</sup> one free after that the fee is \$100.00 each.
- Must be part of 4H, FFA or Grange age 9 as of January 1<sup>st</sup>; Exhibitors are able to compete/exhibit through December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year they turn 19 years of age.
   If Independent must complete independent application with a project management report (see website under Independents) and submit by March 15, 2022. Must be age 9 as of January 1<sup>st</sup>. Exhibitors are able to compete/exhibit through December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year they turn 19 years of age
  - Review and Follow the Independent Exhibitor Application and Rules

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- ☐ **JANUARY** Read the Guidebook per 20 Dairy Cattle; Review all the Junior Livestock Rules, Auction Rules, Check in Times and Show dates.

## **MUST OWN ANIMAL BY FEBRUARY 1**

- Procure Bill of Sale with the following information included: Ownership in Exhibitors name only, the date the animal was purchased, permanent ID #, Breeder name/phone number, amount.
- o If you have bred and raised your own animal, please prepare a statement that your animal was born and bred by you; include address where animal was born, date, permanent ID#, and your/parent signature.
- o Cattle Entries from Other States See Livestock Rules
- You may Exhibit 2 Market Animals only one will be eligible to sell; If you receive a Champion animal
  that animal must sell; If you receive 2 Champion animals the higher placing animal must sell.
- □ YQCA January April 1<sup>st</sup> Take the YQCA Certification Class Retain your YQCA # for your entries
- □ **REPLACEMENT HEIFER APPLICATION March 15** Submit the Replacement Heifer Application (available on the website) including Heifer pregnancy checked and verification, Bill of Sale to 1521 Pioneer Street, Escalon, CA 95320 \*You will still need to register on Blue Ribbon.
- ☐ FARM TO FORK SCHOLARSHIPS Submit by April 30<sup>th</sup> for those graduating Seniors or 1<sup>st</sup> year College students. See the website for more information
- □ **REGISTER TO SHOW BLUE RIBBON** April 1 April 23 Register Online for your Specie Enter through our website for BLUE RIBBON see page 5 on how to create your entry.
  - □ When creating your account be sure that your name is spelled correctly, your address is where your check will be mailed and includes any Apt# or Space # if applicable. Include your leader or parent email address. We do not need your SS#, leave this blank. Be sure to enter the correct YQCA #.
    - Replacement Heifer is Dept 20 Division 7 4H/Grange or Division 8 FFA/Grange Class \$20.00 per market animal
    - Enter your showmanship class \*No Charge

- You will be charged a \$3.00 Entry Fee and a \$3.00 Insurance Fee
- Complete your entries your entry fee should be more than \$6.00

<u>Weekly Parking:</u> This year you can purchase WEEKLY PARKING ONLY through the website when completing your entries. It is DEPARTMENT 50. Weekly parking is \$50.00 from June 9<sup>th</sup> – June 15<sup>th</sup> – no access to the barns on June 15<sup>th</sup>. You may enter through B Street or Martin Luther King Blvd. This is for parking in the B Street or Martin Luther King lots only. Access into the grounds from 6-8 am and 6-8 pm only to drop off/pick up tack. (Weekly parking can also be purchased through our website)

- \$300.00 RV Parking \*Limited to 150 Sold through our website only April 1<sup>st</sup> May 19<sup>th</sup>. This allows for one RV and one Tow Vehicle to be parked by your RV. In and out access available for the Tow-Vehicle.

 PICK UP PARKING/RV PASSES AT EAR TAG PICK UP ON MAY 28<sup>TH</sup> 5-7 PM OR JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup> AGFEST MEETING
 UNIFORMS: Be sure that you are ready to show in your correct uniform. Check the guidebook based on your affiliation. Uniforms must be worn at Shows, Showmanship, Awards (optional) and Sale Day.
 CHECK IN –

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  - Double check your check in times/days for check in. Be sure to have your Yellow Transportation Slip.
  - Heifers that calve prior to arriving at AgFest will not be allowed to show or sell
  - Heifer must be identified by the DHIA accepted number or California Brucellosis ear tag. A readable vaccination (bangs) tattoo must be present in heifer's ear when arriving at Agfest, shield is optional.
  - o All heifers must submit to and pass a Health check
  - If registration information is completed after due dates, a \$50.00 penalty will be required to qualify for judging.

<b>SHOWMANSHIP</b> – Be sure to check to see if you are listed on the Showmanship pages. If not sign up at the
livestock office within an hour of check in.

	WINNING ADVANCED SHOWMANSHIP – Let the livestock office know within an hour of winning showmanship –
	that you will/will not be competing in Master Showmanship; complete your Market Bio and turn into the
	LIVESTOCK Office.
	<b>2<sup>ND</sup> ANIMAL</b> : Get release from the livestock office for all 2 <sup>nd</sup> animals and let them know which animal you are
	taking home that is not in the sale. All Non-Sale animals must leave the grounds by 8am on Thursday.
	AUCTION:
	<ul> <li>Check the Auction catalog to be sure that you are listed both in the Catalog and ONLINE with the correct</li> </ul>
	Lot # (Double check your name spelling as well)
	<ul> <li>Be sure to be ready in line from your lot # for the sale</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Be sure to clean out your pens completely before leaving.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All projects that sell through the auction are subject to the 7% commission fee.</li> </ul>
	NEW FOR AUCTION THIS YEAR:
	☐ Change to this year's auction platform. No Stockshow/Online Auction. The entire auction is LIVE ONLY.
	<ul> <li>Add On's will be accepted through our website (credit card only) or at the sale or mailed in by June 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
	☐ There will be a Buyer/Sponsor Dinner prior to the Auction Sale — hosted by Fungundes Catering.
	CHECKS – AgFest will issue checks to exhibitors within 45 days, of the sale or when payment is received from the
	buyer. Be sure to send thank you notes to each of your buyers and donors.
	<b>FFA CHECKS</b> : Check with your FFA Instructor and guidelines – some of the Chapters require that the checks are
	given to the teachers until the exhibitor's final paperwork is complete.
