website under Independents) and submit by March 15, 2024. Must be age 9 as of January 1st.

CHECK IN –

 Double check your check in times/days for check in; and location and drop off
instructions.
SHOWMANSHIP – Be sure to check to see if you are listed on the Showmanship pages. If not
sign up at the livestock office within an hour of check in.
WINNING ADVANCED SHOWMANSHIP – Let the livestock office know within an hour of winning
showmanship – that you will/will not be competing in Master Showmanship; complete your
Market Bio and turn into the LIVESTOCK Office. Report for Master Showmanship on Friday, see
schedule for times and locations.
