NEW THIS YEAR: WRISTBANDS. ALL EXHIBITORS, PARENTS AND SIBLINGS WILL RECEIVE WRISTBANDS.

EXHIBITORS - YOU NEED TO HAVE YOUR WRISTBAND ON DURING THE ENTIRE AGFEST WEEK. YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE IT ON TO COMPETE IN FLORAL CHALLENGE. PLEASE HELP US MONITOR WHO IS ON THE GROUNDS DURING AGFEST AND EXHIBITING AND CARING FOR ANIMALS.

- If you need to remove your wristband for Work/Sports reasons, please cut it off and bring it to the livestock office for a new one.
 - Lost wristbands – you will get the 2nd one free – after that the fee is \$100.00 each.
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- JANUARY** Read the Guidebook per Dept Entering; Review all the Rules, Check in Times and Show dates.
 - YQCA** is not required
 - FARM TO FORK SCHOLARSHIPS** – Submit by April 30th for those graduating Seniors or 1st year College students. See the website for more information
 - REGISTER TO SHOW – BLUE RIBBON** April 1 – April 23rd Register Online for your Project. Enter through our website for BLUE RIBBON
 - When creating your account – be sure that your name is spelled correctly, your address includes any Apt# or Space # if applicable. Include your leader or parent email address. We do not need your SS#, leave this blank. If you are only exhibiting Still exhibits enter STILLS in the YQCA #.
 - FLORAL CHALLENGE – This will be a fee entry – where you will create a floral arrangement on the spot, on Friday June 14th – see the guidebook for more info.
 - You will be charged a \$3.00 Entry Fee
 - No Insurance Fee is Charged for Still projects
 - Check your email for your entry – review that you are entered in the correct classes. If there is an issue send an email to agfestlvstck@gmail.com Print your email for verification that you are entered.

- **AG ED SCHOLARSHIPS** – May – June 1st – If you would like Donors to donate to an Ag Ed Scholarship for you enter your online application to qualify. Read about the qualifications on the website. You need to sign up to receive any funds donated.

PARKING/RV SPACES

- \$10.00 Daily Parking is sold each day at the Martin Luther King Gate Only. No entrance into the fairgrounds permitted.
 - \$50.00 Weekly Parking – is presold – either through Blue Ribbon through April 23rd, or our website through May 19th. Access onto the grounds is limited to drop off/pick up from 6:00 – 8:00 am or from 6:00 – 8:00 pm You can enter and park in the B Street Lot or Martin Luther King Lot
 - \$150.00 Wall Parking – Limited Parking Spaces sold – through our website only–April 1st – May 19th. This allows backwall parking from June 9th through June 14th (No Sale Day Parking) on a first come first serve space available. Access in and out all day. See the website for more information
 - \$300.00 RV Parking – ***Limited to 150** Sold through our website only April 1st – May 19th. This allows for one RV and one Tow Vehicle to be parked by your RV. In and out access available for the Tow-Vehicle. See the website for more information and RV RULES.

 - **CHECK IN /JUDGING AND PICK UP**
 - Check all times for check in and judging
 - Check all times for picking up your entries after judging. Please note that any items not picked up by the times posted will be tossed.
 - **PREMIUMS** – AgFest will issue Premiums during AgFest. When the Premiums are ready we will announce on the speakers – and you will be able to pick them up at the Livestock Office; please pick up all money by Friday, June 14th.
