Marketing: Jessalee needs help with the marketing sponsorships. She has \$15,000 in sponsorships.

Auction: Brian reported that all swine and beef will go to Clausen's and they will be processed on same day so it will work well for the Carcass Contest. There will be a \$275 processing fee.

Credentials: RV's are all sold out. Parking is still open but closes May 19th. On the RV's there will be a waiting list until Friday at midnight.

Farm to Fork: It will be held on Thursday during AgFest. Prices TBD.
