

Drug Testing:

Use of Drugs

The use by non-veterinarians* of animal drugs or other substances in any manner other than in accord with the labeling approved by FDA is a violation of federal law. Exhibitor and exhibitor's parents and/or guardians agree that:

- (1) They are absolutely and completely responsible persons for the care and custody of their animals.
- (2) By participating in AgFest events, Exhibitor and exhibitor's parents and/or guardians consent to potential drug testing of their animals.
- (3) AgFest shall have the authority to conduct drug testing on any animal participating or being exhibited at AgFest. All drug testing conducted by AgFest shall comply with applicable state laws and regulations regarding animal welfare and veterinary practices.
- (4) Test results shall be kept confidential and only disclosed to relevant AgFest officials and animal's owner/exhibitor.
- (5) AgFest shall be entitled to disqualify an exhibitor whose animal tests positive for any drug, even if the exhibitor and the exhibitor's parents or guardians are innocent of any wrongdoing and did not administer the drug.
- (6) The drug test results of the testing laboratories are final and binding upon the exhibitor and the exhibitor's parents and/or guardians. Even if the source of the drug is unknown, AgFest shall be entitled to disqualify the exhibitor.

* Abuse of the extra-label privilege by veterinarians is unethical and is subject to serious consequences such as license revocation.
