**Auction:** Dena said everything is scheduled.

**Credentials:** Shawna reported that everything is the same as last year including RV's and parking.

**Events:** Julie reported The Farm Bureau will do the buyer's luncheon again. Fagundes wants to sponsor the Dairy Replacement Heifer Sale dinner. There are 37 Replacement Heifers. **Peewee Showmanship:** She has 55 kids entered and Jr. Board will assist. She would like each Barn Chair to assist also. Asking that the older showmanship kids come and assist too. There was a request for a Special Needs kid that is over the peewee age requirement be able to join in with the peewee kids and participate. Everyone was in favor. The Jr. Board wants to add line-dancing to their schedule.

**Jr. AgFest:** Katie reported that Mercy Hollander had been selected as the winner of the T-shirt logo contest. They currently have 39 corn hole boards. There are 27 Jaycees signed up. 22 of them showed up for the first training. Next training will be on the 18<sup>th</sup>. They also received a \$5000 donation from the Canepa's. They were able to assist 19 kids with their campership fees. There is a total of 39 kids signed up for camp.

**Facilities:** Kevin wants to start making lists of the clubs and chapters. Equipment arriving on the 18<sup>th</sup>. Farm workers are coming on May 4<sup>th</sup>. Rabbits also need fencing.

**Farm to Fork:** Jed said he needs paperwork on sale items and a way to have them delivered after the sale. He wants their intent on May 10<sup>th</sup>. **Governance:** Kenny said insurance is to be renewed and he has asked for a price.

**Marketing:** Twyla reported she has \$49,100 in sponsorships. They will close at the end of the month. She has also requested a special board meeting at the end of this meeting. **Next joint meeting will be May 5<sup>th</sup> at new time 6:30 p.m.**
